1. The Thrall City Council will accept public comment on the 2018 Hazard Mitigation Plan and then discuss, take consideration and possible action directing staff to submit the draft plan to FEMA.
2. The Thrall City Council will hear an update about the Roadway Project.
3. Al Clawson will make a presentation about proposed garbage fee increases with and without a recycling program. The Thrall City Council will discuss, take consideration and possible action.
4. The Thrall City Council will canvass the May 5, 2018 election results for the commissioner position and sign resolution. Commissioner Nicole Walla will be sworn in for a two-year term.
5. The Thrall City Council will canvass the May 5, 2018 sales and use street maintenance tax election results and sign resolution.
6. The Thrall City Council will discuss, take consideration and possible action on online payment options for water bills.
7. The Thrall City Council will discuss, take consideration and possible action on an inspection company to require all houses being built in Thrall to have a full home inspection by a licensed inspector hired by the City of Thrall.
8. The Thrall City Council will discuss, take consideration and possible action on holding a second City-Wide Yard Sale on the first week of June since the weather kept some citizens from participating.
9. The Thrall City Council will review financials, minutes, and department reports.

The City Council will conduct a closed meeting under Section 551.071 of the Texas Governmental Code in order to meet with its City Attorney on matters in which the duty of the Attorney to the governmental body under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas authorize and allow such closed meeting and which Rules conflict with the Texas Open Meetings Act.
