

THRALL CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
November 28, 2018 at 7:00 p.m.

Present were: Mayor Troy Marx, Commissioner Scooter Dubec, Commissioner Nicole Walla, Chief Whitney Whitworth, Attorney Mark Schroeder, City Secretary Ginger Gross and guests Salavador Tenajoco, Jose Antonio Barcenas, Dan Armantrout, Jacqueline Chatham, Gregory Martinez, Linda Joines, Randy Joines, Mark Bowed, and Laura Bowed.

Mayor Marx called the meeting to order.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited at 7:07pm.

The Reguladores, a nationwide law enforcement motorcycle club, were recognized by the Thrall City Council. They held a fundraiser at Mel's Lone Star Lanes and presented Chief Whitney Whitworth of the Thrall PD with a generous donation for the Thrall Police Blue Santa Program.
